# Butterflies & Flowers

Finished Size 60" x 76"

Block Size 8"

Quilt by Sue Penn

## Materials Needed & Cutting:

Fat Quarters:

\*BF/G#1, 2, 5, 6, 8, 10, 11 - Hearts

- cut 20 - 2 1/2" squares

Half Yards:

\*BF/D#1, 2, 3 - Butterflies

\*BF/E#1, 2, 3 - Roses

\*BF/F#1, 2, 3 - Small Flowers

- cut 4 - 8 1/2" squares

- cut 20 - 2 1/2" squares

Panel:

\*BF/A#1 - 2/3 yard

- cut 1 panel - 19 1/2" x 21"

Sashing Stripe:

\*BF/C#1 - 3/4 yards

- cut 2 - 3" x 21" strips

- cut 2 - 2 1/4" x 24 1/2" strips

- cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips

- cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 56 1/2" strips

(piece strips together to get 56 1/2" lengths)

- cut 8 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips

- cut 4 - 2 1/2" squares cut on the diagonal

Binding Stripe:

\*BF/C#1 - 3/4 yard

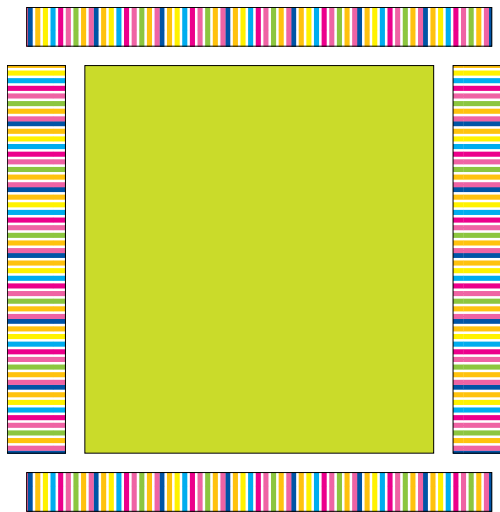
Backing:

\*BF/B#1 - 5 yards

## Putting It All Together:

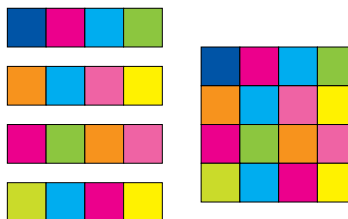
**Center:**

1. Stitch a 3" x 21" strip to each side of the center panel.
2. Stitch a 2 1/4" x 24 1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the center panel.
3. The center panel should now measure 24 1/2" x 24 1/2".



## Blocks

1. Stitch four 2 1/2" squares together in a row.
2. Stitch four of the strip sets together to make a block.
3. Mix and match the 2 1/2" squares so each block is different.



## Quilt Top

1. See quilt diagram and stitch all of the blocks, 8 1/2" squares and strips together. You will end up with two extra 8 1/2" squares.
2. Be careful to make sure that the 2 1/2" striped squares all point to the center of the quilt.
3. Layer with batting and backing and quilt.

4. Bind with striped fabric.
